



Health and Safety Protocols for Opening the Christine Center Main Facility

As we continue to be in the midst of a global pandemic, The Christine Center has developed health and safety protocols to ensure the safety of guests and staff upon the reopening of the main facility for group retreats.

Along with increased disinfecting of the facilities by staff members, we will be asking guests to follow protocols for entering shared spaces.

Cleaning Protocols

In addition to our existing cleaning protocols, we have added additional disinfecting processes each day to the shared areas of the main facility public restrooms, as well as thorough disinfecting between guests in all accommodation types. This includes sanitization of all surfaces and furniture.

Guest Supplies

No Christine Center yoga and meditation supplies will be available for guest use. We are asking guests to bring their own yoga and meditation supplies.

Spirit Jewel Bookstore

In addition to masks, we are asking guests to use gloves to handle merchandise in the bookstore. Gloves will be provided at various locations around the bookstore and should be discarded after one use.

Hand Sanitizer

Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the property. We are asking guests to use hand sanitizer when entering the main facility and frequently throughout your stay with us.

Health Checks

Temperature Checks

Guests, as well as staff, will have body temperatures taken prior to entering our retreat center via touchless thermometer. Per CDC guidelines, individuals with a body temperature greater than 100.4 degrees will unfortunately not be allowed to enter the facility.

Notifications

Guests are asked to alert the Christine Center Operations Manager or Program Director if they test positive for COVID-19 within 14 days of their visit to our facility. We will email

notification to retreat leaders of all potentially exposed persons if there is a confirmed case of COVID-19.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

Face Covers

We have provided our staff with facemasks and gloves, which are required to be worn in public spaces when interacting with guests, such as serving meals. Guests are also required to wear face coverings in shared areas.

Social Distancing

All spaces in the center will be set up so that seating is at least 6 feet apart. We ask that all guests practice social distancing at all times, unless you have come with someone with whom you already have contact.

Smaller Group Sizes

We are currently limiting retreat groups to a maximum of 20 guests.

Lodging

At this time, we will only be accepting single reservations, unless you are coming with another guest with whom you already have contact.

Meals

We will no longer be using the buffet-style for our meals. Our kitchen staff will prepare plates to serve to guests.

The dining room will be set up for social distancing. Additional space for eating is set up on the patio. Other rooms in the center will also be set up for social distancing for meals, in the event we have inclement weather.

If during your stay, you start showing any of the common symptoms for COVID-19, please notify a member of our team immediately. You will be asked to stay in quarantine until tested. The Christine Center will support you throughout the process, can provide meals for you in your room, and work with you to arrange for a COVID test.
