## **Welcome Christine Center Guests**

### **Protocols For My Health and Safety**

The staff and Sisters of the Christine Center welcome you back to the Center. Every effort has been made to create a safe environment during your stay. We ask that you agree to comply with the following guidelines to the best of your ability when entering the main Center building.

#### **Health Check**

We ask that you please stop at the reception desk daily to have your temperature checked. A staff member will be available to check your temperature with a contactless thermometer.

Additionally, guests are asked to notify the Christine Center Operations Manager should you test positive for Co-V within 14 days after your visit to the Center.

#### **Social Distancing**

We request that you maintain social distancing of 6 feet with staff and participants during your time at the Center. Meeting and dining spaces are being designated with this concept in mind. We ask that you not move chairs from their designated spaces.

#### **Face Masks**

We ask that you wear a facemask when you enter the main Center building and when you are moving within the spaces of the building such as meeting rooms, bathroom, bookstore, and chapel.

You may wear your own facemask. Facemasks will also be available at the entrances of the building.

#### **Hand Sanitizer/Handwashing**

One of the best measures to prevent the spread of Co-V is handwashing.

To be most effective wash your hands for at least 20 seconds using warm water and liquid hand soap available in all the Center's bathrooms.

We also ask that you please use the hand sanitizer located at the doorways before entering the Center.

#### **Meals**

We currently are not able to serve meals in our customary buffet fashion. Meals will be plated in the kitchen. We are using biodegradable plates for your protection. You may sit in designated spaces in the main dining room, Pines, Birches or outside as weather permits. We ask that you dispose of paper and compost in the containers provided.

#### **Bookstore**

When you are perusing books and items for sale in our bookstore, please continue to use a facemask. We also ask that you wear disposable gloves or use hand sanitizer before handling merchandise. We also ask that you pay for purchases with credit card or check at the front desk. Cash, may be used in the envelopes provided in the bookstore. The staff will not be able to provide you with change at the front desk.
